



Is My Respect in Sport - Parent Certification Valid?

2020-2021 Season

If you have previously completed the Respect in Sport – Parent program and are unsure if it is still valid, you can check one of two ways:

1. [Respect in Sport website](#): Log in to your profile and on the home page, you will see at the top right corner beside the RIS logo:

Please verify that the expiry date is May 1, 2021 or later. If program status shows a green CERTIFIED (if you are viewing this information after May 1, 2020), you are fine and do not need to re-certify this year.

2. [Hockey Canada – e-Hockey website](#): Log in, click “View” beside your child's name and look under Qualifications for “Respect in Sport (Parent)” - it will reflect the season you took the course and the applicable expiration date. If the expiration date is May 1, 2021 or later, you are fine for the 2020-2021 season. If the expiration date reflects May 1, 2020 (or prior) you will need to re-certify. Note, if you have taken the course more than once you will see both indicated. Make sure one of them has the proper expiration date of May 1, 2021 or later.
