



The following protocols will be observed at all City of Calgary operated facilities

PARTICIPANT INFORMATION

Entry & Exit – participants may arrive 30 minutes prior to the ice time. They and must go straight to their assigned dressing room and can not leave that space until they go on to the ice. Participants must vacate the dressing room 15 minutes after their ice time and must immediately exit the facility.

Masks – masks are required when entering and exiting the facility, once in the dressing room masks can be removed. Bench staff are required to wear masks on the players' bench.

Warm-up – participants may warm up outdoors only, the use of public areas within the facility is prohibited. If participants arrive more than 30 minutes prior to their ice time to warm up outdoors, equipment must be left in vehicles until they will be entering their assigned dressing room.

Water Bottle Fill Stations – where available.

Showers – are available however participants are still required to exit their dressing room 15 minutes after their ice time.

SPECTATORS

Entry & Exit – spectators may enter at the start of the ice time and must exit immediately afterwards.

Masks – masks are mandatory at all times while in the facility.

Capacity – spectator capacity is limited to 100 per rink. It is the responsibility of the user to ensure this number is not exceeded.

Other – Spectators may not congregate in the lobby or other common areas. Spectator areas will not be disinfected or cleaned between ice times – spectators should attend only on an as needed basis.
